RESOLUTION NO. 2007-29

**A RESOLUTION INCREASING THE WATER, SANITARY SEWER, AND SOLID WASTE RATES FOR CUSTOMERS OF THE DURANT CITY UTILITIES AUTHORITY**

---

**WHEREAS**, the Durant City Utilities Authority has reviewed the cost of operation; and

**WHEREAS**, the cost of operation for water, sanitary sewer, and solid waste has increased significantly; and

**WHEREAS**, it is necessary to increase the rates for water, sanitary sewer, and solid waste collection and disposal due to the cost of operation.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Chairman and Trustees of the Durant City Utilities Authority:

**Section 1:**


That the following five-year plan for rate increases will apply to the current utility rate schedules for water, sanitary sewer, and solid waste collection and disposal, and that a detailed copy of the new rate schedule will be attached to this resolution as Attachment A:

1. *Water customers of the City Utilities Authority:* Increase rates by 3.5% each year through FY 2012.
2. *Sanitary Sewer Customers of the City Utilities Authority:* Increase rates by 3.5% each year through FY 2012.
3. *Solid Waste Collection and Disposal Customers of the City Utilities Authority:* Rates applied to residential, commercial and industrial customers, as well as to Durant C&D Landfill and Transfer Station shall increase by 3.5% each year through FY 2012.
4. *Water and Sewer Tap Fees:* Increase rates by 3.5% each year through FY 2012. (Reference Resolution No. 2007-17 for Contractors/Developers fees)

**Section 2:**

That the effective date of all rate increases specified in this Resolution shall be July 1, 2007.

**PASSED AND APPROVED** this 18<sup>th</sup> day of June, 2007, by the Chairman and Trustees of the Durant City Utilities Authority.

**Rural Water District Rates: Set by Contract**

**Industrial Water Rate** (Ref. Resolution No. 2005-33)

1. If usage is less than one (1) million gallons per month, the customer will be charged the regular water rate.
2. If usage is one (1) million gallons or more per month, all water usage will be charged at a 20% discount off the regular city rates.
3. Industrial rate customers shall agree to purchase a minimum of 500,000 gallons of water per month in order to qualify for the industrial water rate.

**Conditions for Industrial Water Rate** (Ref. Resolution No. 2005-33)

1. The industrial customer is located within the city limits of the City of Durant.
2. The industrial customer utilizes all available city services, which are in addition to water service, to include sanitary sewer service and solid waste collection service.
3. The industrial customer is located in an industrial zone and is engaged in manufacturing or processing.

 For residential sewer customers of the Durant City Utilities Authority whose sewer bill is based on water consumption, sewer usage shall be based on a maximum water usage of 10,000 gallons for the months of may, June, July, August and September.

 Customers shall be charged based on water usage as reported by the Rural Water District, if available.  
 If water usage information is not available, a flat charge shall apply for
